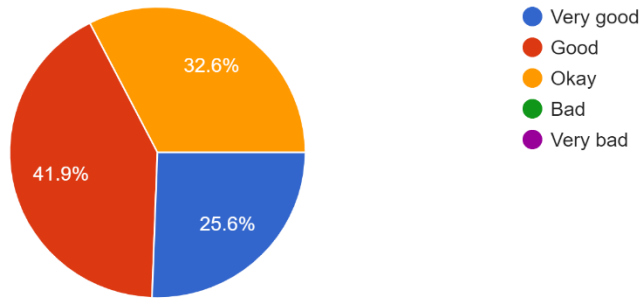


Thank you to all who completed the Sex and Relationship Education Survey. The outcomes were generally very positive and we appreciate your input. Here are the results:

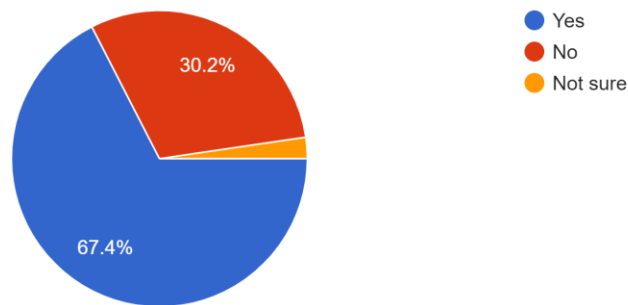
Based on what you know about the relationships and sex education currently provided for children at the school how would you rate it overall?

43 responses



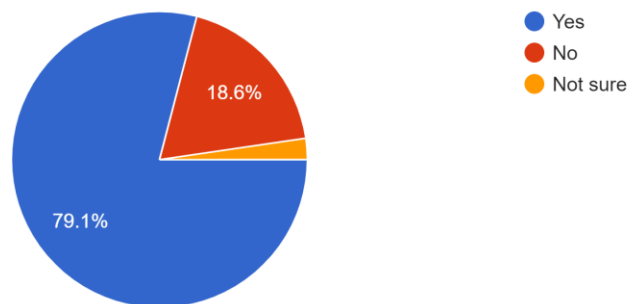
Did you know that a change in the law means that all primary schools are required to teach Relationships Education and Health Education from September 2020?

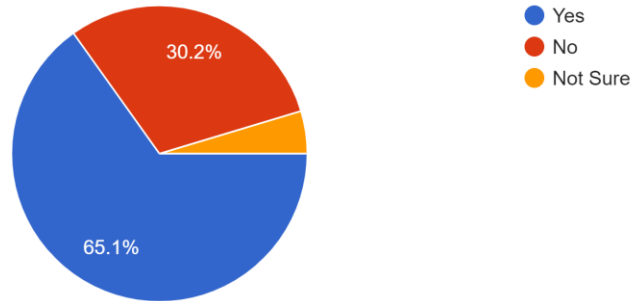
Did you know that all primary schools are recommended to teach sex education, and that parents continue to have the right to request that their child is excused from sex education?

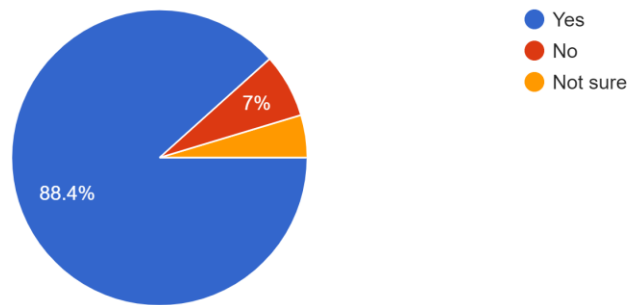
Has your child ever talked to you about something they learnt at school to do with growing up, sex or relationships?

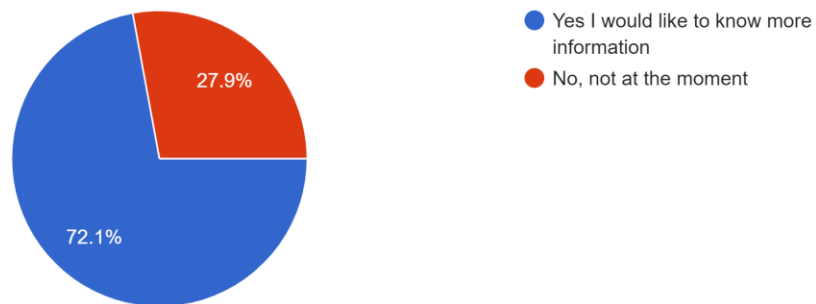
Did you know that many children want to learn about growing up from their parents and carers as well as from school?

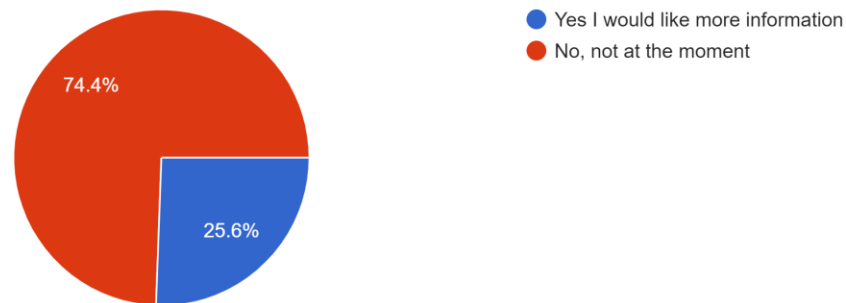
Would you like more information about what our school teaches on relationships, health and sex education?

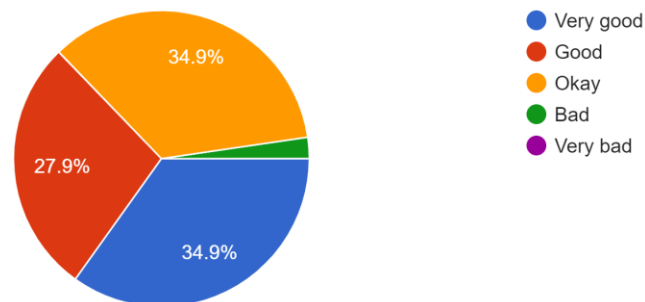
Do you want more support to help you talk to your child about relationships, health and sex issues at home?

Thank you to all parents and carers who took the time to complete the survey. In response to the key findings, we have taken the following actions:

- The knowledge grids we use for RSE topics with children will be shared with parents via class dojo before we teach the unit. This will give you a really clear overview of the key knowledge we will cover in lessons.
- We will continue to inform you (via class dojo) of when SRE lessons will be being taught.
- As we have already had workshops for parents and carers of reception, Key Stage 1 and also Key Stage 2 this academic year our next workshop will take place in autumn term 2023.
- These workshops went into great detail sharing the content of the SRE lessons, the age groups they are delivered to and the resources used to help teach the lessons.
