Baking Club



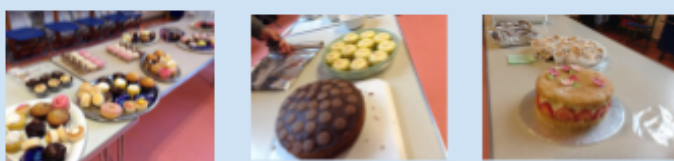
